July 29th - August 1st

TT&RR and the Municipality of Jenne organized a workshop in Jenne to inform the local stakeholders and the municipalities of the Track Jenne-Anzio about the submission of the certification at Council of Europe, with the local stakeholders and the municipalities of the Track Jenne-Anzio.
